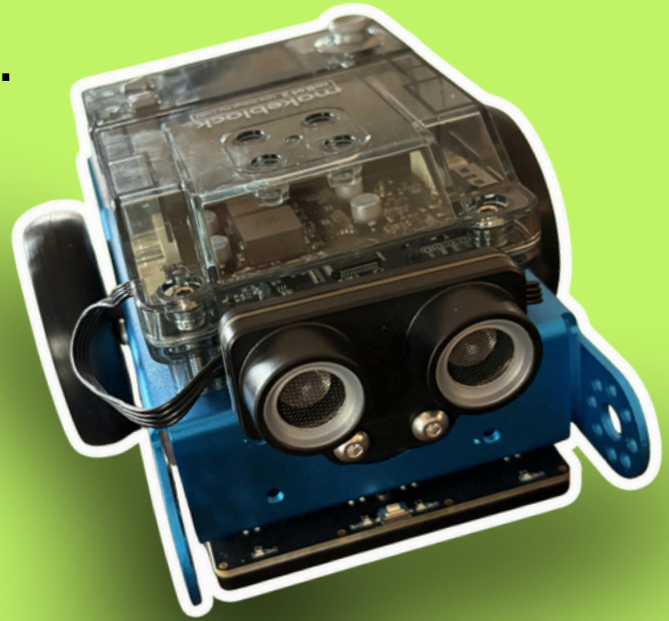
WE ARE HAPPY TO ANNOUNCE THAT...
